





- Open Sept. 8 22










- 80 percent of the county was without power on September 11



Crop damage to citrus estimated to be about \$93.5 million










Estimated total Polk County Costs = \$45.7 million FEMA reimbursement – 75% (\$34.3 million) State reimbursement – 12.5% (\$5.7 million)






Total Budget FY 2017-2018

Taxable Values


vs. Annual Trend




Ambulance, Fire and Other Responses

FY 2012-13 to FY 2017-18














